In picturesque Somerton, this ancient inn overlooking the market square and pretty church has 8 bedrooms - each with their own quirky charm. Some have claw-foot bathtubs, others retro wallpaper or antique trunks; all have super-comfortable beds and indulgent local Bramley products. But best of all is the laid-back [restaurant](#), run by an ex *River Cottage* chef, whose ethos is local, seasonal produce. We visited on a Sunday afternoon, which called for deliciously smoky roast beef with all the trimmings. Looking around, we saw a happy mix of couples, families and groups all enjoying a homely rural welcome. Lovely stuff.
